Aged care in Australia is changing. From 1 July 2019, the Australian Government will be implementing the Single Charter of Aged Care Rights, which amalgamates the four charters that operated previously. This is being done to make it easier for recipients, their families and carers to understand their rights and responsibilities in aged care.

It's important to understand how the new Charter will affect you, so Older Persons Advocacy Network is developing resources to assist aged care recipients, providers and carers to understand and implement the new Charter. These will include:
