

Seniors Got Talent Terms and Conditions

1. Eligibility:

All participants must be aged 55 years or older

Entries must be submitted by 20 July 2026

ADA Australia will review all applications and advise if you have been successful to participate in the talent show.

2. Performance Rules:

Performances may include musicians, bands, dancers, spoken word or other forms of performance art.

Participants must provide any technical specifications for their act in advance, such as music audio on a USB or other.

Performances must be free of offensive language, inappropriate material and content that infringes on copyright laws. The performance must not breach the Anti - Discrimination Act 1977 No 48. Any form of breach of these guidelines will result in an immediate stop to the performance, and performers may be asked to leave the event.

3. Health and Safety:

Participants must comply with all directions from the stage manager.

Performers are responsible for providing and the safety of all stage props and instruments.

Equipment must be used appropriately and safely.

Any safety concerns must be reported promptly to the stage manager.

4. Photographs and Promotional Material:

ADA Australia reserves the right to use photographs or video footage from the event for promotional material including social media and publications. Members of the public are welcome to take personal photos during the event. Please advise ADA Australia if you do not wish to have photos or footage used for promotional purposes.

5. Behaviour and Conduct:

Participants are expected to act respectfully. Offensive performances will result in an immediate stop to the performance, and performers may be asked to leave the event.

6. Changes to the Event:

ADA Australia reserves the right to make adjustments to the event schedule, including start and end times, the location or venue, the list of performers or activities and other event logistics. These changes may be implemented due to unforeseen circumstances such as severe weather, health and safety concerns, technical issues, insufficient attendance or other operational challenges.

Notifications of significant changes will be provided to participants and attendees via email, phone and/or public announcements as soon as reasonably possible.

PRIZES AND RULES

Prizes:

Judging Criteria:

Creativity and originality 30%

Talent and technical skill 25%

Stage presence and audience engagement 25%

Overall impression 20%

Judges may use an 'Applause Meter' to gauge overall impression

Judges will score each performance individually and the average score will determine the winners.

Judging Panel:

The judging panel will include 3 individuals.

Judges will be briefed on the scoring system.

Judges will be required to declare any conflicts of interest should a participant be known to them.

Tie-Breaking Procedures:

In the event of a tie, judges may use an 'Applause Meter'

Prize Distribution:

Prizes will be announced and presented during the event.

Transparency and Dispute Resolution:

The decision of the judging panel will be final.
